This book explores the world of birds, including water birds (geese, plovers, and penguins), land birds (crows, cockatoos, and eagles), early birds (archaeopteryx and ichthyornis), and extinct birds (dodo, great auk), as well as bird behavior, migration, and anatomical features like beaks, feet, and feathers. Illustrated with captioned color photos or drawings on nearly every page, this compact encyclopedia for readers 8 and up is stuffed with detailed information, making it an engaging refresher for adults as well. Each topic is presented in clear, bulleted points, while "Did You Know?" fact panels appear throughout. 384.
