

It is well enough, too, that this House and the rest of mankind, have thus been enlightened by their views of the object and purpose of the war, of the mode of its successful prosecution, of the great and crying sin of slavery, of its abolition by Executive proclamation, and of the nature and character of the coming year of jubilee. All this, sir, is well enough, but none of all this is involved in the subject matter properly before the House for discussion. Nor is it necessary in this debate to resort to questions foreign to the resolutions. The issues directly involved are broad enough, embracing, as they do, the great absolute right of Personal Liberty to the American people. I propose therefore in what I shall say to confine my remarks to the two-fold right asserted by the President and impliedly denied by the resolutions, the right, first, to arrest without process of law, and second, to detain without benefit of habeas corpus, free citizens of the...
